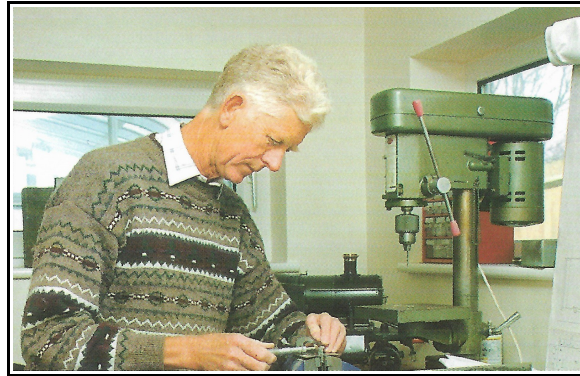

Lawrence G Marshall RIP

Lawrence G Marshall, a retired senior bank manager wrote a number of books on railways and has left us a wealth of information about Spanish railways in the 1960s. His first visit to Spain was in 1956 whereby he fell in love with the country and developed an interest in her railways. During his lifetime he accumulated more than 7,000 photographs of steam locomotives from around the World including over 3,000 from Spain.
